Part time invigilating job opportunity at All Saints Academy:

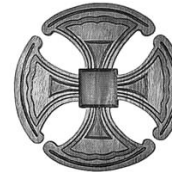
Gardener wanted: If anyone is able to spend some voluntary time to tend a garden and mow the lawn etc. please let Lesley Watson know.
