### Upcoming Parish Services:

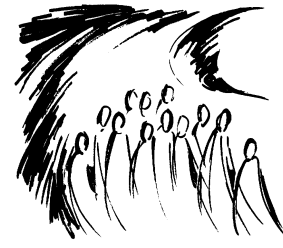
**Thursday 30th May:** Parish Eucharist for Ascension Day 7:30pm at St Fremund's.

## Christ Has Risen

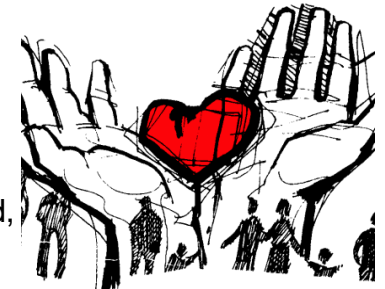
