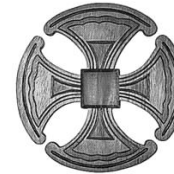
There will not be services at St Augustine's, St Fremund's or St Katherine's on the 9th. There will be an 8am Eucharist at St Peter's as usual.
